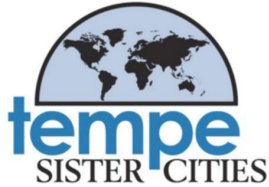

International Educator Exchange Program Expectations

International Educator Exchange Snapshot: Educators who are selected to participate in the exchange are paired up with individuals who have applied in cities and towns who exchange with the Tempe Sister Cities (TSC) Program. After thorough, purposeful planning, educators from Tempe host a visiting educator for 3 weeks. This process is then reversed as the Tempe educator travels abroad and lives with their host for 3 weeks (same breakdown). While in schools, educators are expected to have Q & A sessions with students and teachers, possibly teach a small lesson on Arizona, and attend various activities in your honor. TSC provides airfare for Tempe Educators selected to travel, gifts for select dignitaries, arranges all visits to the mayor of Tempe, school board meetings, TSC meetings and provides a network of individuals ready to help transport and entertain the visiting educators during their stay in Tempe.

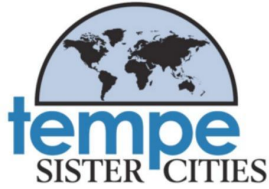
Purpose of the International Educator Exchange: The objective of this program is to provide an opportunity for educators in Tempe to develop professional, educational growth, cultural understanding, and lasting friendships with the people of exchange cities. Possible cities are Regensburg, Germany; Lower Hutt, New Zealand and other international countries through a reciprocal home hosting and school teaching experiences.

Educator's Commitment

There is a significant commitment required if you are selected for the International Educator Exchange. The following list is critical for a successful travel experience. It is essential:

- To have the support of those you live with (family, roommates) for your participation and time commitment for this exchange.
- To plan ahead for family commitments so you will be available for all mandatory exchange activities. (See Calendar Page 3)
- To understand this is a professional educator exchange and is NOT for independent travel/activities before or after the educator exchange. As a participant in the exchange, understand that this program does in no way include a spouse, family member(s), or friend(s) for this overseas travel. While abroad, the Tempe educators will live in the homes of their host educators. Educators are expected to be professional and to be cooperative in the family living experience.
- To adhere to the educator exchange travel date calendar, including air travel schedule provided by the TSC.
- To attend orientation meetings before the departure date, attend calendar meetings before guest arrives¹, participate in TSC activities (two Shoulder to Shoulder Socials, Oktoberfest), speak briefly about the exchange experience after returning at several meetings, and generally help plan and promote the exchange program.
- To be prepared to interact with students and the teacher, present a mini lesson, teach or participate in a game, engage in a two-way question and answer session, deliver a brief presentation on Arizona, or to simply walk around the classroom and absorb what is occurring. While all activities are not necessary, teachers generally are less stressed when they are over prepared.
- To open your home and act as a gracious host(s) to our guests by providing appropriate sleeping quarters/accommodations.

¹ Calendars for arriving guest teachers must be submitted 3 weeks prior to guest's arrival. Calendars will be created in calendar meetings with your country liaison.



Costs

Air travel expenses will be paid by the Tempe Sister Cities Corporation; this is unique to our program. You will provide your own spending money. The families in our exchange countries will provide room and board. Participants will reciprocate “in kind” when their exchange hosts become our guests here as they did for you while visiting them. Upon selection, participants are required to join the Tempe Sister Cities.

Previous participants have experienced out of pocket expenses as part of the reciprocating, which vary depending on activities and group plans. Please communicate with your exchange partner with clear expectations regarding cost.

Other Hosting Expectations

- Room accommodations at your home
- Food for your guest (prepared or readily available)
- Transportation - While TSC will assist with driving guests, it is expected that you will be responsible for planning transportation for the duration of your guest’s stay.

You will have the following expense here: (based on your and/or group decision)

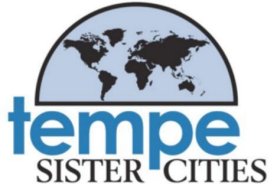
- Travel expenses while here for your guest (bus fare, light rail, etc)
- Meals out for your guest (individually or as a group)
- Activities and event entry fees (museums, zoo, athletic events, ets)
- Travel trips seeing the State of Arizona
- Miscellaneous expenses and purchases

All expenses above are incurred by your host teacher while you are in their country; therefore, you are expected to incur the same **financial responsibilities** for your visiting teacher. All financial arrangements are to be made prior to the exchange.

Any plans/group activities agreed upon by the group members must be **paid equally by all members** of the group.

Typical Dates for Travel

Each departure date will be varied due to host countries’ schedules. The actual exchange trip for the Tempe educators to Germany, New Zealand, or other participating international countries will be 3 weeks in the summer of 2025 (June/July); however, the specific travel dates are still to be determined.



Application Requirements

Each applicant must:

- Be a US Citizen.
- Be employed by an accredited school within Tempe city limits of the following Districts:
 - Tempe Union High School District
 - Tempe Elementary School District
 - Kyrene School District
 - Parochial, Charter, and Private schools
- Have a minimum of three years teaching experience completed at the time of application.
- Continue employment with their current Tempe district/school for the following school year.
- Be a full-time educator.
- Must have a valid Passport by the end of February.
- Submit a Copy of Current Covid Vaccinations.
- Previous participants of the Tempe Sister Cities International Educator Exchange are not eligible to apply.

Applications

Informational posters are located at the District Offices of all TUHSD, TD3 schools. Only Kyrene Elementary and Middle Schools within the boundaries of Tempe are eligible to participate. In addition, explanatory fliers are available at all principals/headmasters' offices. Applications can be obtained on the Tempe Sister Cities website (<http://www.tempesistercities.org>, select programs, select Educator Exchange). All completed applications must be received by one of the following individuals on or before Monday, January 9th 2023.

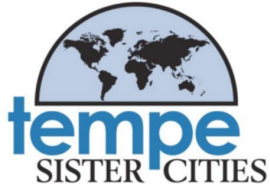

International Educator Exchange Agreement

I agree, if selected, to represent my Tempe community as an educator ambassador and visit Regensburg, Germany; Lower Hutt, New Zealand or Trollhättan, Sweden. Non-compliance with this agreement may cause forfeiture of participation in the Tempe Sister Cities International Educator Exchange.

Specifically, **I agree to the following:**

1. I will **attend all mandatory orientation sessions**. Missing sessions will necessitate your removal from the educator exchange.
2. I agree to join and actively participate in the Tempe Sister Cities Corporation (TSC) through the 25-26 year, including working Oktoberfest the second weekend of October, 2025.
3. I agree to adhere to the Educator Exchange travel date schedule and **to depart and return to the U.S. as a group member**.
4. I agree that neither my spouse, my partner, nor any other family member(s) or friend(s) will join me while I am on the exchange. Violating this part of the agreement will be grounds for **total reimbursement by the participant** of any and all costs incurred by the Tempe Sister Cities organization (plane fare, etc.)
5. I will be a considerate and responsible guest in the exchange guest's home that I visit and will be a gracious and concerned host when my exchange guest visits Tempe. I understand that I must reciprocate "in kind" for my guest. My visiting teacher will be my priority while here. Flexibility makes this enjoyable for all those involved.
6. I will **adjust my schedule and attend all functions** that will be held/sponsored by the Tempe Sister Cities International Educator Exchange.
7. I will be available to give talks about the Tempe Sister Cities program, plan and promote the program for the following 25-26 school year. I will write a short article, attach a photo and submit it to the TSC Core Team Editor upon my return.
8. I will file for my passport by the end of January and provide a copy of my passport to Linda Parrish by March 14, 2025.
9. I understand that participants **travel at their own risk**. I will make individual arrangements for medical coverage, liability and travel insurance. An additional travel/health insurance policy is recommended and available to you at minimal cost. (contact coordinator for the country)
10. I will return to my district/school for the 25-26 school year.
